ETHNIC LIAISONS FOR THE CHRISTIAN COMMUNITY

ETHNIC LIAISON: An Informal Partnership of a small number of churches coming together across racial lines for Evangelism, community service and community transformation in the Name of Jesus Christ.

- **Step 1**: Church A takes the initiative to reach out to a small number of churches representing different racial/ethnic groups/congregations for informal partnership.
- **Step 2:** Once the churches agree to the partnership, the first activities are prayer and fellowship, that may include cultural exchanges, awareness.
- **Step 3:** Multi-ethnic church leaders come together to plan joint Evangelism and community service activities. The ethnic liaison may target one major focus of need, or multiple focuses. All community service/Christian charity activities have a strong Evangelism focus, so the Gospel is preached in both spoken words and actions.
- **Step 4:** The ethnic liaison implements the Evangelism and Gospel-focused community service projects. These may include Biblical justice-based actions.
- **Step 5:** The ethnic liaison leverages the media, social media, conferences, word of mouth, etc., to tell the world about their ministry successes to build God's kingdom based on racial reconciliation, unity, love, and standing strong with communities, including people in need.

The Christian ethnic liaisons will build stronger Christian multi-ethnic consortia in the cities and inspire the formation of additional Christian multi-ethnic consortia for Evangelism and service from the grassroots. The result is a unified church; an energized church; great witness of love, service and racial reconciliation in the churches for non-Christians to see.
